

## STANDARD PROCEDURE FOR RECORDING THE SAFETY TRAINED SUPERVISOR CONSTRUCTION® (STSC) CERTIFICATION IN IW-ATS

- 1. Once an ironworker member has successfully passed the STSC® examination, the member must submit to their local union training coordinator a copy of the certificate sent by the Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP) verifying that they passed the exam.
- 2. The local union training coordinator will scan their certificate into their computer system.
- 3. Following submission of the certificate to the local union training coordinator, the coordinator will ensure that the certificate is recorded in the Ironworker Apprentice Tracking System (IW-ATS).
  - 3.1. Once the certificate is recorded in the IW-ATS, the certificate should appear on the Iron Worker Membership Card.
